Dear Mr Landaus

I write further to our previous correspondence and your request for a response to correspondence forwarded by you in October 1999 concerning alleged breaches of the Mining Act 1971.

In essence, you wanted to know whether the police would investigate what you assert to be breaches of the Mining Act 1971 by the Crown.

I am advised that this is not a police matter. Accordingly the police will not carry out an investigation. I also understand that the police have previously provided you with advice to the same effect. As the matter relates to the Crown Minerals Act 1991 (and its predecessor, the Mining Act 1971), you should continue to pursue your complaints through the Ministry of Economic Development (formerly the Ministry of Commerce).
