During this period I personally discovered vast new jade reserves under the Mining Acts and expended over \$2 million in the process of exploration, mining licenses and business development in the region only to have everything taken away from me, without any compensation from the Crown, whatsoever.

Having property development interests most of my adult life, I moved to Golden Bay and developed two properties there with a two year break in Australia as manager of three motel/apartment complex's.

I consider I have a wealth of experience in social and family situations having come from a large family myself, and living within a large family unit in New Caledonia.

Since year 2000, I have been caregiver and guardian to my two nieces now aged 22 and 24 years.

As motel - apartment manager in Australia, I was also regularly involved in various mediation and social issues involving cliental and their various personal and business relationships and situations.

As well as the skills listed in the previous positions of employment, I have a sound general knowledge and experience in computer technology and software, IT, HR, general engineering, building and construction, concreting, electrical and plumbing, motor mechanics, architectural design, photography, accounting, business management and marketing.

When placed in an employee or contractual situation, my loyalty to the employer is paramount.

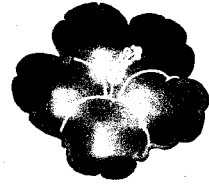
Without this relationship I would not be able to accomplish the things I enjoy doing.

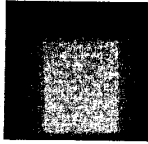
I have known Mr Kenneth James LANDAUS for a period of about ten years. I have found him to be a responsible, and co-operative member of the community.
